## **INFRASTRUCTURE**

The School building consists of three storeys, each consisting of four blocks and a new block.

- ♦ Ground floor engulfs Principal Office, Administrative Room, Smart Class Rooms, well equipped, spacious and well ventilated full size laboratories for Physics, Biology to meet the needs of Secondary and Senior Secondary stage. Well equipped library with reference books on all subjects, Encyclopedias, Dictionaries in different subjects, Examination Room, Senior Computer Lab with required number of modern computers with internet connectivity, Fashion Studies Lab, Home Science Lab for senior students providing update knowledge with practical aspects of life, First -Aid Room, Staff Rooms and spacious Class Rooms for senior students.
- First floor covers a huge fully air conditioned Auditorium with a capacity of 1000 persons, Smart Class Rooms, Physical Education Room comprising equipments of different sports, a creative Commercial Art Room, for senior students, Fine Arts and Craft Room, well carpeted and spacious Music Room, Junior Library, Two Computer Labs for Junior students, a well-equipped Maths Lab with latest calculating Methods/Patterns introduced by C.B.S.E., a Language Lab which helps to acquire strategic competence to use in a wide range of communicative strategies, Staff Room and Class Rooms for Secondary Students.
- Second floor constitutes Co-ordinators' Office, Staff Rooms, Smart Class Rooms, well-equipped Social Studies Lab with the aids of innovative approach and spacious Class Rooms for junior students.
- New Block comprises a well-equipped Chemistry Lab, Audio Visual Room that gives a live multimedia experience, spacious Class Rooms for Senior Students and ATAL Tinkering Lab which gives a vision to cultivate Children in India as Neoteric Innovators.
- Apart from it, there is a separate block for Clerical Staff, a wide reception hall with a capacity of 100 visitors & a big playground for upliftment in the health of students.
- ◆ There is a facility of water cooler on ground, first, second floor and in new block. Generator facility is also provided in case of electricity failure.

#### A. Laboratories

- 1. Science Lab: The school is having separate laboratories for Physics, Chemistry and Biology. The aim of these labs is to create active interest in scientific learning and to develop scientific attitude in students.
- 2. Maths Lab: Without any use of Maths, there will be a pause all around the world. It is, therefore a significant subject but the main problem is the way of presenting the subjects especially with a child of less aptitude. The school aims to make this subject easy & simple and in order to comprehend certain difficult concepts, our lab is well equipped with basic models and theorems in Maths.
- **3. Home Science Lab**: "Home Science is concerned with the attainment of the well being of individuals and families, the improvement of homes and preservation of values significant in home life" Ellen Richard.
  - Keeping the views of Ellen Richard in mind, the school has started Home Science as a subject for XI & XII class students. To make this subject interesting and appealing, different practicals are organised by the teacher in Lab.
- **4.** Social Science Lab: To make this theoretical subject simple, lucid and easily understood by the students, We have, well maintained S.St lab with the aid of innovative approach like projects, models, etc. so that our students are able to understand this subject interestingly.
- 5. Computer Lab: "A Computer is a combinations of IT Basics, IT Tools and IT Applications and Much more...." This School trusts in Providing an ample opportunity to its students to ensure consistency. So, we are providing three Computer Labs with Projector and Hi-Tech Computers having internet facility.
  - Senior Lab is mainly meant for classes XI and XII and Junior Labs are for classes VI X.

- **6.** Commercial Art Lab: Commercial Art is a part of Applied Art. The objective is to increase creative skills among students. They can be self dependent by adopting any of its courses after XII. In future, they can become a freelance Landscape artist, Book cover designer, Poster designer, Good calligrapher etc.
- 7. Fashion Studies Lab: The School has a Fashion Studies Lab to provide the students independent course in the field of Fashion Studies. This is a path consisting of modular studies and points out their skills in drawing, knowledge of fabrics designing and garments stitching moreover Fashion Studies provides the comprehensive opportunities that prepare the students for their future careers in this field.
- **8.** Music & Dance Room: "Music & Dance are God's most magnificent and delightful gifts that bring joy to the body and calmness to the soul".
  - Keeping this view in mind, we have a well-equipped Music and Dance room having various musical instruments. Students learn there to play different musical instruments and also learn different forms of dances.
- **9. Gymnasium**: The school has a gymnasium for the students to build up strength, stamina and speed that are vital for games & sports.
- **10. Smart Classrooms**: In an era of IT revolution, teaching can not stay far behind. Teaching at the school is a fine blend of latest multimedia technology. Students get all the ICT support in their Smart Class Rooms and are encouraged to perform as digital learners.
- 11. Audio-Visual Room: Our school has a well-equipped & furnished Audio-Visual room. The main purpose of having this facility for students is the fact that whatever is seen by our eyes is retained by the brain more effectively than just reading or listening to it. The A.V. Room caters for junior as well as the senior sections of the school. Latest technique of multimedia projector is employed here. The many faceted Audio-visual Room is used to show visuals and slides pertaining to study different subjects, to demonstrate theorems, rules in Physics laws and experiments. It helps to visualize the experiments to be performed in Labs and it shows practical Day-to-Day Applications of the Scientific Laws. Students can also demonstrate their prepared projects with the help of Projector.
- **12.** Language Lab: Our school constitutes a well-furnished Language lab which is used for learning through teacher's console and Language Learning Software. It acts as a platform for learning, practicing and producing language skills through interactive sessions & communicative mode of teaching. It helps to maintain good linguistic competence through accuracy in grammar, pronunciation & vocabulary.
- **13. ATL (Atal Tinkering Lab):** In order to create an environment of scientific temperament, innovation, creativity among the students, our school has taken an initiative to provide activity based learning where young minds can give shape to their ideas. As truly said by Robert A. Heinlein: "Everything is theoretically impossible, Until it is done".

So, it is a step towards a new India that will embrace and encourage novel and innovative ideas and inventions. As technology is the torch which illuminates the world, as the nation will remain the first which carries the works of thought and intelligence farthest.

#### **B.** Library

An overall development of mind is always in need of healthy, sound & tranquil environment. Keeping this thought in mind we are having two well-equipped libraries in our school. One is Junior Library mainly meant for classes VI-IX and other is Senior Library mainly for X-XII. These two libraries have more than 32,000 books and an ample space where students can read. Certain features of our school libraries are:-

- Well stocked foreign edition of books.
- ♦ Book sets and refreshers for board students.
- ◆ Encyclopedia and reference books.
- ◆ Number of magazines is about 35 monthly.
- ◆ Facility of one library card is given to the students to have an opportunity to issue two books for enhancing their reading capability.

#### 1. The School Curriculum

The School is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. It is only for girls from VI to XII. It prepares the students for the All India Secondary and Senior School Certificate Examination. Upto class X all subjects are compulsory. At + 2 Stage i.e for classes XI & XII the school provides three streams - Science, Commerce and Humanities.

- ♦ The 26<sup>th</sup> batch of Class X, consisting of 458 students, will appear in the All India Secondary School Examination scheduled for March 2023.
- ◆ The 24<sup>th</sup> batch of Class XII, consisting of 428 students, will appear in the All India Senior School Certificate Examination scheduled for March 2023.

#### 2. Examinations and Promotion Criteria

The School follows a system of assessment through Class Tests, Periodic Tests, Half Yearly Examination, Annual Examination and special assessment for class X and XII in the Academic Session.

The School is following Remodelled Assessment Structure, offered by C.B.S.E. for classes VI-IX & XI. There are two Periodic Written Tests with Half Yearly Examination & Annual Examination. Assessment of Scholastic Area pertaining to Board Examination & Internal Assessment (for Periodic Tests, Notebook Submission and Subject Enrichment Activities) for the main subjects. The School is promoting co-curricular activities for the holistic development of the students.

It is imperative that the child must pass in both the terms separately for the promotion to the next class. Progress Report of the students is sent to their parents twice during the session, once at the end of Half Yearly Examination & finally after Annual Examination.

## 3. Faculty Members

The School has a highly qualified team of experienced teachers under whose able guidance, the students pursue their studies and cope up themselves in different fields. Ratio of teacher and students is 1:25 in the school. Every care is taken by the teachers to develop the talents and potentialities of our students.

## B. Personality Development



#### (1) Co-Curricular Activities

The School lays special emphasis on co-curricular activities as they make the girls more initiative and develop good habits. They also led to an all round development of personality. Various Competitions such as group and solo song, debate, essay writing, quiz & art competition are being held on alternate Saturdays throughout the year.

#### (2) Inter School Activities

The School organises various inter school activities to build confidence which may enable them to take up any challenge that may come across in life. The School has been and will be representing the school in various Inter-School competitions like Dance, Debate, Painting, Rangoli, Mehandi, Athletics, Hockey, Skating, Kho-Kho, Basket Ball, Net Ball etc.

#### (3) Houses

The students of the school are divided into four houses named **Laxmi, Gargi, Kasturba and Teresa.** Each House works under the guidance of House Incharges and other team of teachers that encourage and help them to take part in various co-curricular cultural activities and competitions. The School lays great emphasis on these group activities as they help in all round development of personality of the students and brings out best qualities of character i.e. leadership, co-operation, discipline, self sacrifice and self control.

#### (4) Dramatics

The students put up plays in English & Hindi and Dance performances covering different topics and impart various lessons and morals to the entire school.

## C. Physical Development

## 1. Physical Education & Gymnasium:

Besides training of intellect, the school lays stress on sound health of the students. Physical exercises and games are compulsory so that the students enjoy good health and sound mind. Girls play the following games: Basket Ball, Badminton, Throw Ball, Kho-Kho, Volley Ball, Table Tennis etc. The School maintains extensive play ground for this purpose. A special room is equipped for gymnastics and other physical exercise.

The Annual Sports day is organised in the month of December / January every year and the winners are awarded with prizes and certificates. Students are also trained & motivated to participate in the Inter School, District level, State Level and National Level Competitions.

#### 2. Self Defence:

For self defence Judo and Taekwondo activities are organised weekly in Activity Period. Trained coaches are provided to Junior as well as Senior sections.

## Special Features

- 1. School Management is providing Scholarship in the form of Fee concession to the meritorious students of Board Exams and Home Exams.
- 2. a. Shri Thakurdwara Balika Vidyalaya is affiliated with C.B.S.E., New Delhi and is not receiving any financial aid from Government. School Management is offering fee concession by their own for the purpose of girl's education to the genuinely needy girls who, fulfill the conditions to get fee concession as per school policy and school reserves the right to grant the fee concession. However, no fee concession is allowed in the first year of admission.
  - Blazers/Uniform/Text material are also given to the genuinely needy girls.



## **SYSTEMS AND PROCEDURES**

#### **Admission Policy**

- 1. Prospectus and application for Admission to classes VI to IX and XI will be available at the school reception on the payment of Registration Fee of Rs. 500/- (for Classes VI to IX) and Rs. 1000/- (for Class XI).
- 2. Application form completed in all respect should be submitted at the school reception.
- 3. Candidates will be admitted on the basis of merit secured by them in the written test. The decision of the Principal about admitting a candidate will be final and the Principal has not to assign any reason for the refusal of any admission.
- 4. The Candidate admitted to the school will abide by all rules framed by te school regarding :-
  - (a) School Timings and Time-Table
  - (b) Holidays and Leave
  - (c) Examination and Promotion
  - (d) Fee Structure and Mode of Payment
  - (e) Discipline
  - (f) Dress Code
  - (g) Any other-matter

#### Admission to Classes VI to IX

Admission will be on the basis of written test which will be held in the school at the given time and date on the submission of application form. The test will be of 120 minutes.

Admission to classes VI to IX will be subject to the applicants producing following documents:-

- (a) Marks-sheet of the last examination passed
- (b) School Leaving Certificate
- (c) Photostat copy of Aadhar Card of Candidate as well as Parents.

#### NOTE: THE PROCESS OF REGISTRATION AND ENTRANCE TEST DOES NOT GUARANTEE ADMISSION.

#### Admission to Class XI

The admission of our school candidates in any stream of XI will be on the basis of Pre-Board results and afterwards Board results. Admission Fee will not be refunded in any case. The following documents should be submitted along with application for admission:-

- (a) Photostat copy of Marksheet of Class X Examination/Pre-Board Marksheet.
- (b) Character Certificate issued by the school last attended.
- (c) Migration Certificate for application who have passed Class X Examination from Boards other than CBSE.
- (d) Stream will be given by the Principal on the basis of Board Result.
- (e) Stream once given will not be changed.
- (f) Photostat copy of Aadhar Card of Candidate as well as Parents.

Admission will be for Science, Commerce and Arts Streams. Details of subjects/combination of subjects to be opted by the students will be communicated at the time of issuing the prospectus for admission to Class XI.

#### NOTE: NO NEW ADMISSION IS ALLOWED IN CLASS X AND XII.

#### FEE REGULATIONS

- i. Every Student will deposit the fee for full year (12 months) on monthly basis. The fee once deposited will not be refunded in any circumstance.
- ii. Fee will have to be deposited from 1st to 15th of every month.
- iii. Late fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged upto 25th of the month after that, fine of Rs. 100/- will be charged till end of the month.
- iv. From the next month fine of Rs. 200/- will be charged upto 25th, after that the name will be struck off and Re-Admission charges of Rs. 1000/- will be applicable if the student wants to continue.
- v. Two months fee will be charged in the month of May (May and June).

#### GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

- 1. Students should attend the school regularly. The entrance door will be closed after the ten minutes of school timings.
- 2. Late comers will be allowed to enter the premises only on the submission of written requests from the guardians.
- 3. All the students must attend the school in clear and tidy uniform.
- 4. Students attending less than 80% classes will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- 5. Medical leave will be granted with the consent of the Principal. If a student continues to be absent for three days without any information, her name will be struck off and in case rejoining, the re-admission fee will be charged.
- 6. The Principal may ask the parents to withdraw their children, in case they do not fit in with the regulations of the school or are not capable of any improvement or if the parents themselves do not co-operate with the school authority.
- 7. No Student should be found roaming outside the class except during lunch break. Only under unavoidable circumstances the student will leave the class with the written permission/pass from the monitor of the class.
- 8. No student shall put/carry any kind of Ornament / Mobiles.
- 9. If a student is found irregular in attending regular classes, strict action will be taken against that student.
- 10. School authorities won't hold any responsibility of your ward outside the school premises after school hours.
- 11. All the students should carry their School Diaries and Identity Cards with them, failing in it they will not be allowed to enter the class, labs, library and school functions.
- 12. Students returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, should produce a doctor's certificate permitting her to do so.
- 13. Students must obey Captains, Monitors and other students on duty.
- 14. No student should be indulged in any of the following practices namely:
  - a. Spitting in or near the school building.
  - b. Damaging or disfiguring the school property.
  - c. Rowdyism or rude behaviour.
  - d. Use of violence in any form.
- 15. Students should get their Report Cards signed by their Parents / Guardians within three days of the receiving and return them to their class teachers. If lost or damaged, a fine will be imposed.

#### **RULES FOR PARENTS / GUARDIANS**

- 1. Parents / Guardians are the chief educator and guide of their ward. So it is obligatory for the parents to attend the PTM.
- 2. Parents / Guardians shall not enter the class directly and are not allowed to meet the concerned teacher without prior appointment.
- 3. Through the SMS facility, parents are intimated about the regular absence of their ward. So, parents are advised to pay attention to that SMS also & kindly keep their mobile no. updated.
- 4. Guardians may contact the Principal from 9.00 A.M. to 10.00 A.M. on working days.
- 5. Decision of the Principal on all disputes shall be final and binding.
- 6. Please check hair, nails, uniform and punctuality of your ward in the morning.
- 7. Check your child's diary daily. Do sign the remarks, if any and take necessary action.
- 8. If you observe that your child is not assigned home work sometimes or unable to follow the lesson, the Principal or Class Teacher should be contacted.
- 9. Encourage your child to take balanced interest in studies, co-curricular activities and sports.
- 10. Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities in enforcing regularity and discipline. They should take an active and helpful interest in the activities of the school.




